Treasurer report was given; Money received from members. Expenditures this month was; Port-a-Jon, folding tables.

**Items:**

Field Drainage; Work day scheduled will be after the Magnolia Classic Fly-in. Time and date to be announced.

Items to bring to work day: Two types of shovels (digging ends to be flat and others pointed), work gloves, wheel barrows/carts, lawnmowers, edge trimmers, tractor with a box blade or scraper blade.

Plans are to cut a ditch between the shed and pilot pads to drain toward the existing storm sewer and clean out the existing storm sewer.

Fill in low spots, such as near the Port-a-Jon and over by the container area. Cut back sod at the pilot pads south sides so water will drain off the pads and or raise the pads. We may need to sow some grass seed when all is done.

Magnolia Fly-in date: May 12, 2018. Time of event; Registration starting at 8:30 am. Flying at 9:00 am. Members need to be at the field at 7:30 to set up tent and tables. Members are asked to forward flyer information on the Magnolia Classic Fly-in to other Clubs.

A \$5 meal ticket gets hamburgers, chips, fixings and soda.

The landing fee is \$15 and that includes a meal ticket.

Sellers in the parking lot will need to pay \$5. We will have tickets for Pilots draw, food and maybe sellers.

The Auction is a "FMS F4U Corsair V2 Blue 1700mm (67") Wingspan – PNP", that was donated to the Club by Jack Gibson. The Club thanks Jack for his donation.
